CRITERIA AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR LICENCE TO REMOVE EXPLOSIVES (FOR BLASTING WORK OR PYROTECHNIC EFFECTS)

Criteria for Grant of Licence

To be eligible for a licence to remove Explosives you must meet the following criteria:

For applicant	 Be a fit and proper person. The criteria and requirements for a person to be considered fit and proper to hold a licence are (but not limited to) whether the relevant person has honesty, integrity, a good reputation, competence and capability. For more details, you may refer to the main menu on Criteria for Grant of Licence.
For company	 Registered with the Registry of Companies and Businesses One of the directors of the company is a Singaporean Possess a licence to deal in explosives All staff involved in the removal of explosives are approved by the Licensing Officer Possess a licence to conduct blasting (for blasting works) Exempted under the Dangerous Fireworks Act (for pyrotechnics effects)

Documents Required

You are required to obtain the following documents before applying for the licence.

For Fireworks	Fireworks display must be exempted under the Dangerous
Display	Fireworks Act.

For Blasting	Submit the blasting proposal giving details of the place and
Work	method to be used in the blasting together with the
